MEMORANDUM OF UNDERSTANDING ON MUTUAL COOPERATION

between

THE COLLEGE OF EUROPE

and

THE YOUNG CELL SCHEME (ROUND XI-XII)

The College of Europe Bruges and Natolin Campuses, hereinafter “the College” and the Young Cell Scheme, hereinafter “YCS”, desirous to establish, develop and further strengthen cooperation between the Parties have agreed the following.

Article 1

The College and the YCS will collaborate with the view to facilitating for up to 6 students of each academic year (up to 3 full scholarships for the Bruges Campus and up to 3 full scholarships for the Natolin Campus) wishing to study at the College to avail of the YCS, starting from the academic year 2019/2020. Such scholarships will be equally distributed between the two campuses of the College of Europe.

To this end all Parties agree to introduce measures aimed at overcoming technical and administrative issues which would preclude candidates from the application for studies at the College and at the same time from applying for scholarships granted by YCS.

In view of the above, YCS:

- will include in information on the YCS, both in publications and electronic, the fact that candidates may apply for scholarships for the College,
- will inform candidates of the special measures introduced for candidates for the College,

- will inform the Admissions Office in Bruges and the Communications and Recruitment Office in Natolin of names of grantees who expressed the wish to study and complete their Master studies at the College as their first choice.

By the same token, the College:

- will inform on the College website of the possibility of benefiting from a YCS scholarship by candidates wishing to study at the College,
- will inform candidates who have been granted a scholarship by the YCS and wish to study at the College of the procedure for filing an application past the standard College applications deadline,
- will inform the YCS of the results of the application procedure concerning those candidates who were indicated to the College by the YCS and are considered for a YCS scholarship.

Article 2

The full scholarship at the College is 25.000,00 Euro and it includes tuition, board and lodging. For students at the Natolin Campus the scholarship also covers two students' academic study trips, as well as costs of the Summer Language Academy and the Preparatory Courses for those who would so require. For the students at the Bruges Campus the scholarship also covers the academic study trip as well as participation in the Introductory Courses.

Upon the issuance by the Bruges Campus and the Natolin Campus respectively of an invoice detailing all costs for each student admitted to the respective campus, the YCS will transfer a 25.000,00 Euro scholarship covering one year master studies for each student enrolled there to a bank account indicated by the Bruges Campus and the Natolin Campus respectively.

Should a surplus be identified by YCS between the scholarship granted by it and the cost of the full scholarship at the College, the Scheme will act in accordance with its internal rules and may also grant the difference directly to the student concerned.

Article 3

Any amendments to the Memorandum will be done in written form only, by consent of all Parties.

Article 5

Any disputes related to implementation of the Memorandum will be resolved in good faith and by agreement of all Parties.

Article 6

The memorandum will enter into force on the day of its signature.

Each Party may renounce the Memorandum by notifying the other Parties in writing, with 30-days' notice.

The memorandum has been signed in three identical copies, in English in Bruges, on the date 2. X. 2018, in NATOLIN, on the date 8. X. 2018 and in Pushkina, on the date 19. X. 2018.

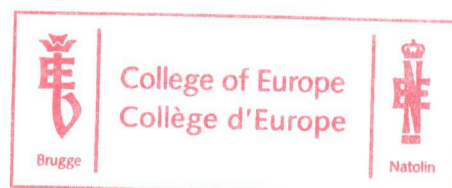
